On behalf of the Take Heart Association Project (THAP) Board of Directors, I am pleased to submit this progress report on how THAP is using the \$10,000 grant your Foundation awarded us in January 2015.

Irene Mukuria, THAP's Program Coordinator, in Nairobi has secured updated cost estimates for the generator, refrigerator, and washer/dryer for the THAP Family Support Center. The total cost difference from the budget detailed in our grant proposal is only \$143.45. Irene will be purchasing the equipment and arranging for deliveries and installations in April.

January and February were busy months for THAP as we were preparing the medical cases for children on our waiting list to be evaluated by the U.S. Hearts of East Africa medical mission. This medical mission team, which has operated on THAP children in the past, visits Tenwek Hospital in Bomet, Kenya each year. Five THAP children were chosen for heart surgeries in February and I am delighted to report that all are doing well.

I will inform the Foundation when the equipment is installed and functioning in the Family Support Center. Once again, our thanks to you for your generous support.
