CONFERENCE POLICIES: THE DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF EARLY-BIRD REGISTRATION IS OCTOBER 1, 2020. Conference registrations will only be accepted when accompanied by a check, money order or credit card information. Registrations will not be held without payment.

CANCELLATION POLICIES: A written cancellation request must be received by October 1, 2020 in order to receive a refund. A \$75 administrative fee will be applied to cancellation refunds. The cancellation policy also applies to registrations that are received and accepted after the deadline date. (If cancellation is requested after deadline and is accepted, there will be a \$100 administrative fee). Substitutions are acceptable at any time (non-members substituting for members will be charged the difference between member and non-member fees). CONTINUING LEGAL EDUCATION (CLE) CREDIT:

To apply to a State not listed above, it is the individual's responsibility to collect any handouts or other information required by that States' accreditation board for individual submission and self-certification. Individual on-line credit applications are not accepted by all States.

To Receive a Certificate of Attendance:

1. Your EBA online profile or registration must include your bar # and state.
2. You must sign-in by logging into the session for which you want credit.
3. No later than October 31, return to EBA, your attendance form including CLE codes provided during each session.
4. Attendance forms without bar # and state will be voided.

Certificates of attendance will be emailed to eligible participants in November.

To assure accreditation, the necessary CLE information must appear on your registration form. You should also add your bar numbers to your profile with EBA. If your bar number or state are missing, we cannot guarantee receipt of credit. Only registered attendees are eligible for CLE. Students are not eligible for CLE.

EBA HARDSHIP POLICY:
