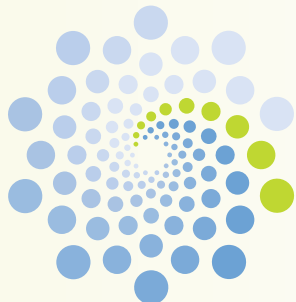

CANCELLATION POLICY.
