CONFERENCE POLICIES:

THE DEADLINE FOR RECEIPT OF EARLY-BIRD REGISTRATION IS April 12, 2022. Conference registrations will only be accepted when accompanied by a check, money order or credit card information and may be limited by the capacity of the facilities. Registrations will not be held without payment.

CANCELLATION POLICY. Refunds will be given to registrants who submit written cancellation request to the Energy Bar Association, 2000 M Street, N.W., Washington, DC 20036 by April 30, 2022 or by sending a written cancellation request by email to Richelle at RKelly@EBA-Net.org. There is a \$75 administrative fee for cancellations. No refunds will be given after April 30, 2022. The cancellation policy also applies to registrations that are received and accepted after the deadline date. (If cancellation is requested after deadline and is accepted, there will be a \$100 administrative fee). Substitutions are acceptable at any time (non-members substituting for members will be charged the difference between member and non-member fees). Please note that regardless of the date the cancellation notice is received, no refunds will be processed until after the program.
