Bob Hellrich-Dawson is Senior Economist with the Office of Energy Market Regulation-West at the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission. Currently Bob works in the Commission's Folsom, CA office, focusing on the California ISO and EIM markets, and the west in general. He has extensive experience leading and providing economic analysis to support Commission orders and rulemakings, having worked with all of the US RTO and ISO markets, with a focus on ancillary services markets and the integration of energy storage resources and renewable resources. Bob is involved in the Commission's current work on primary frequency response and multiple price formation efforts and led the Commission's Order No. 755, *Frequency Regulation Compensation in the Organized Wholesale Power Markets* rulemaking.
