

Joey joined Tellurian in 2017 as President of its pipeline companies. In this role, his primary responsibilities are to lead the development, execution and operation of the Tellurian and Driftwood pipeline assets to ensure the safe, efficient and reliable delivery of natural gas from the various production basins to the Gulf coast, which include the Driftwood LNG facility. Prior to Tellurian, he spent the previous 10 years at Energy Transfer serving as Executive Vice President of Engineering and Construction and an additional six years as Vice President of Regulatory and Environmental Affairs at Cheniere Energy. Over his 25 year career in the energy business, it has been focused on delivering energy infrastructure across the United States. Projects have included investments from small to mega infrastructure projects routinely greater than \$500MM and upwards of \$12B for both multi-state regulated and non-regulated pipeline developments as well as fixed facility developments for NGL, LPG and LNG import and export projects, gas processing plants and fractionation facilities.
