

Cindy Miller consults on projects on energy, telecommunications, broadband and regulation. She served for 27 years in a range of positions at the Florida Public Service Commission. These included Associate General Counsel and head of the Commission's External Affairs Division. She primarily focused on rulemakings and appeals in the electric and telecommunications arena, as well as analysis and comments with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission and the Federal Communications Commission. She has now headed her consulting firm, Cindy Miller LLC, for five years. She has provided consulting services for the University of Florida Public Utility Research Center, the South Carolina Public Service Commission, The Nature Conservancy, the Environmental Defense Fund, a municipal electric utility, and the First Amendment Foundation. She also assisted the Southern States Energy Board's Blue Ribbon Task Force on the Puerto Rican Energy Grid. She was part of a team on helping develop transparency in the energy arena for Uzbekistan, through the National Association of Regulatory Utility Commissioners and U.S. A.I.D. She is also co-chair of the Florida Chapter, Federal Communications Bar Association. She most recently was on a team focused on a suggested broadband strategy for Florida. She has assisted in developing and hosting programs in the energy and telecommunications fields for a couple of decades, and moderated panels.

She was awarded the Jason Leif award by the Energy Bar Association in 2021, which recognizes exemplary long-term service by a member of an EBA chapter.
